

Laps to Lapland

Your reindeer needs to get back to Lapland to pull the sleigh in time for Christmas Eve!

Your Daily Mile will help them to fly back home - every time you complete one, add it to the map and see their journey unfold.

Will they get back in time to deliver the presents? It's down to you!



Instructions:

1. Display your map so you can follow your reindeer's journey back home.

2. Name your reindeer!

3. Fill in the gaps on the sheet:

- Start = your school name
- End = total miles from your school to Lapland
- Some milestones along the way

4. Colour or number the snowflake-steps as you go!

Once you have done your Daily Mile, move your reindeer on by one map-mile.



Why take part?

Get your children involved in the run up to Christmas with an exciting countdown to the end of term, by helping your reindeer get from school to Lapland, using your Daily Mile.

Track the journey from your school to Lapland using the resources provided.

How does it work?

To start, search how many miles it is from your school to Lapland - don't worry if it seems impossible! With the simple formula below, everyone can get there using their 'map-miles' equivalent.

Get your children to help work it out:

A: Miles from school to Lapland

B: Number of school days left in the term

$A \div B =$ the number of 'Map Miles' that each Daily Mile counts for
(1 collective Daily Mile completed = 1 map-mile)

For example:

A: 2000

B: 35

$2000 \div 35 = 57$ real-miles per day = 1 'map-mile' = 1 Daily Mile
The reindeer will move by 57 miles on the Lapland Map, after 1 Daily Mile completed.
